**WYSC - Equipment and Uniform Report**

The 2011/12 soccer season has seen the successful introduction of a new uniform for the U11 – U18 divisions in the club.

As well as the on field uniform there are also players' track suits, hoodies, toques and duffel bags which are available for purchase. The introduction of a coach's jacket has also tied into the overall look for the club. Coaches also have the option to purchase pants for which there has also been interest.

The Board is pleased to announce that all coaches in the club will be given a Coach's Jacket as it will bring unity to the coaches, regardless of division. The rollout of the coaches' jackets for the U7-U9 divisions will occur this spring.

Currently I am available at any time if anyone is wishing to purchase these items which are in stock, and arrangements can be made directly with me. Going forward I will organize 2 or 3 order dates throughout the year to ensure the items are available and ready for the soccer season start up dates.

There has been a variety of equipment purchased this year to restock our supplies for all divisions. The list includes:

- First Aid supplies

Next spring will see the large and medium sized goalie nets replaced at Myrtle Philip and Whistler High School. Going into the next soccer year will see the purchase of more pop up nets for the U7-U9 divisions and any other equipment requests and requirements will be reassessed in the spring.
